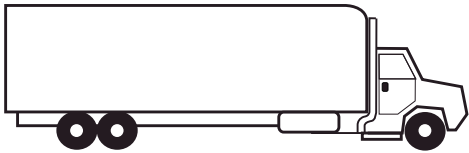
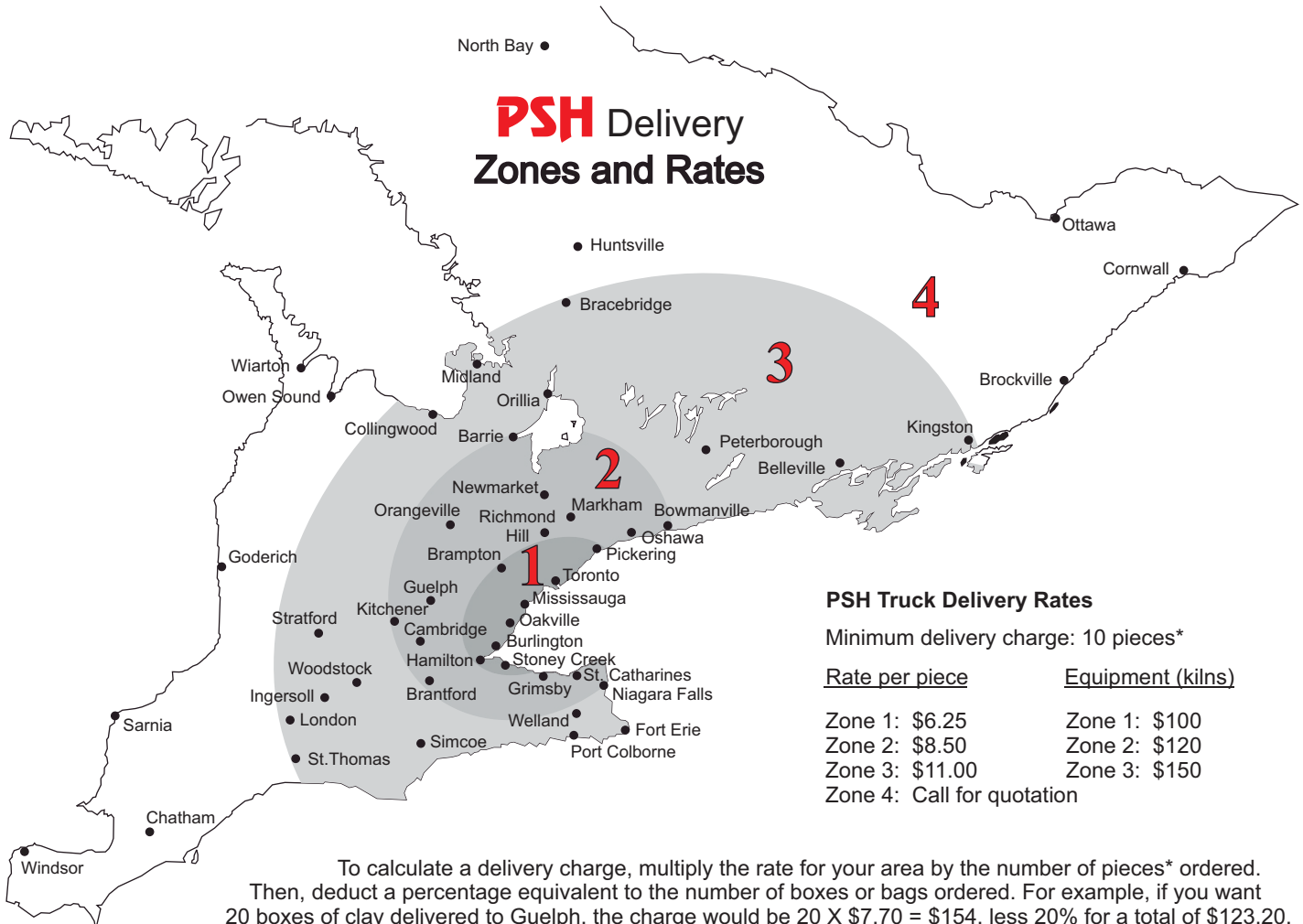




Small Shipments: The UPS or postal charge depends on shipment weight, size and destination. Most small orders ship for less than \$20; call for a quote. U.S. customers pay no tax. There are no brokerage fees on orders under \$200. Collect shipments are subject to a \$3 - \$10 handling charge per package.

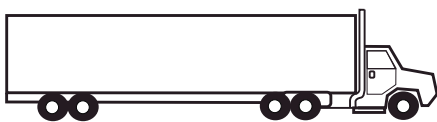


Large Shipments: The Pottery Supply House delivers to sites throughout Southern Ontario by Jet Transport every week. Hamilton, the driver, will help place your order where you like it if you provide help. Customers in Zone 4 may get faster and, sometimes, more economical service if shipped by commercial carrier. Call for delivery options and a quotation.



To calculate a delivery charge, multiply the rate for your area by the number of pieces* ordered. Then, deduct a percentage equivalent to the number of boxes or bags ordered. For example, if you want 20 boxes of clay delivered to Guelph, the charge would be $20 \times \$7.70 = \154 , less 20% for a total of \$123.20. The maximum deduction, 52%, is applied to the delivery charge on orders of 52 or more pieces. A delivery of fewer than 10 pieces is charged as if it were a 10-piece delivery. See above for rates on kilns and other large pieces of equipment.

* Piece: box of clay, original bag of dry materials, potter's wheel. Other supplies, excluding equipment, ship freight-free.



For shipments to areas beyond those serviced by Jet Transport, we will quote on shipping by another carrier. Quotations include heated service, power tailgate and/or inside service if required. Note: Collect shipments are subject to a \$10 per pallet/crate handling charge. Additional charges apply if inside delivery service is requested at the time of delivery.
